Speakers:

Christina Clarke is an Advisor with the PDST and has been involved in the design, development and delivery of CPD in the areas of Literacy, L1 English, JCT English, SSE& Literacy and Religious Education. Christina is on secondment from Marino College, where she taught English, Religion and EFL. This workshop will explore the role of the school Librarian in the planning and support of Literacy through the process of School Self Evaluation. The workshop will provide opportunity for the contribution of the librarian to be considered, explored and discussed.

Charles Quain is the Director of Interleaf and will make a presentation to demonstrate the simplicity of *Leabharlann*, a collection of ebooks, eAudiobooks and streaming video worth over €20,000, available for an annual fee of €650.
